Your Booth Space will NOT be reserved until the enclosed application, pictures or slides, full payment and list of menu items to be sold are received and approved by the Florida Seafood Festival Vendor Committee. DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS IS Sept. 30, 2016, or until booths are filled.
- 2. Only products with prior approval will be allowed for sale at festival. Any changes or additions MUST be approved in advance by the committee. No Exceptions allowed!! Items for sale by Arts & Crafts Vendors shall be handmade. No Buy/Resale. No
- 3. We will mail you notification of acceptance or denial within 15 days of receipt of the application only if you include self-addressed envelope. Acceptance will be dependent upon receipt of your application, pictures and payment. No further contact will be necessary.
- 4. BOOTH APPEARANCE IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT!! Exhibitor must furnish their OWN canopy, tables, chairs, trash receptacles, etc. The more attractive your booth, the better you will sell. Be prepared for rain or shine as the show will go on! **All booths must be well secured in case of bad weather. Security will be provided in park, however, the Festival board is not responsible for any missing or damaged

products.**

- 5. Welcome packets containing booth assignments, tax information, gate passes and parking will be given upon check in at the front gate in Battery Park.
- 6. Designated areas for RV parking will be available in limited supply (on a first received application / first served basis). RV's must be self-contained as far as POWER/WATER and SEWAGE are concerned.
- 7. Setup will be on Thursday, November 3rd from 9:00 5 p.m. Gates open 10 a.m. and close at 12 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.
- 8. Booth fee is non-refundable. All booths must be set up by 5:00 pm on the 3rd. **NO MOVING TRAFFIC ALLOWED AFTER 5:00 DUE TO STRICT INSURANCE LIABILITY. MUST HAVE VEHICLE OUT BY 5:00 p.m. if going to need it.*

Vendors not complying with this rule will be subject to removal from the Festival without refund of their fees.

- 11. No Vendor may break down before Saturday, November 5th 11:59pm EST.
- 12. No Vendors may sell outside of festival grounds.
